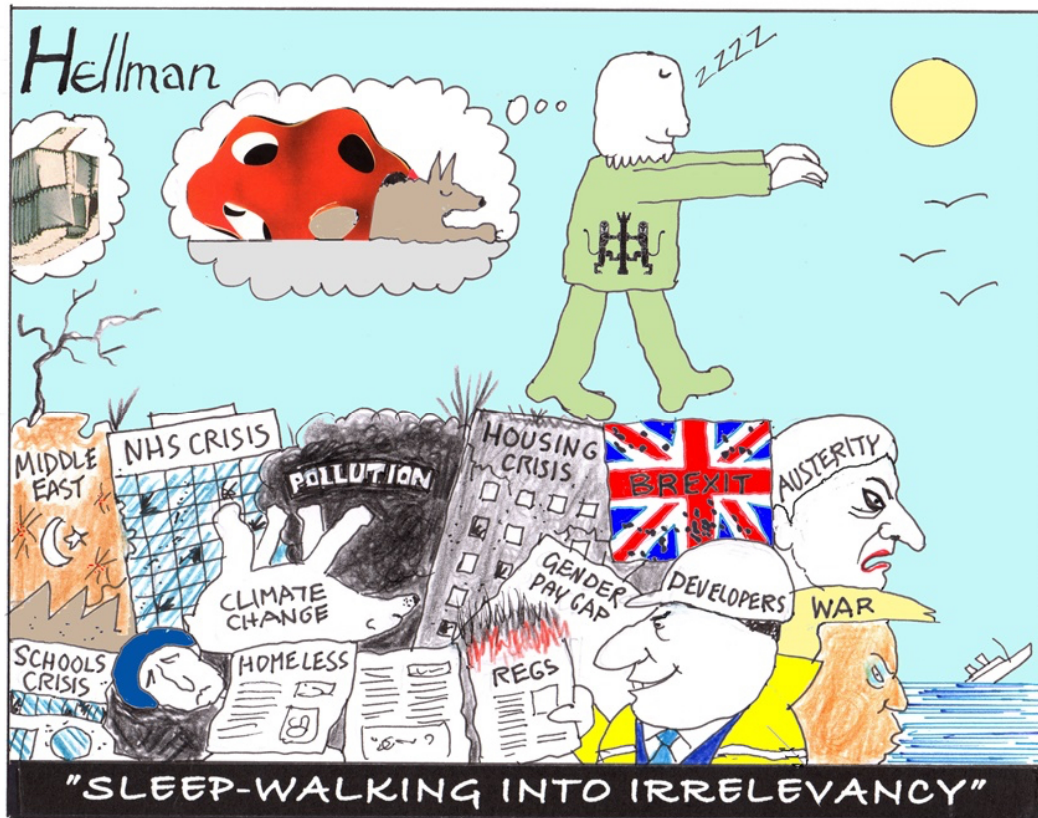


Sleepwalking into Unsustainability

In 1963 the RIBA published its very first Plan of Work, which contained Stage M - Feedback, when the architect and other team members would go back to the building and find out how it was working. In 1979, the RIBA published a 96-page free book *Buildings - the Key to Energy Conservation*, which included 50 case studies of buildings designed and mostly completed in response to the oil crisis five years before. Now, half a century later, one might have expected building professionals to be highly knowledgeable about the performance in use of their buildings - but instead we have Grenfell Tower and the Performance Gap. Bill will explore why this happened and asks how we can respond to our self-inflicted climate and environment emergency.
