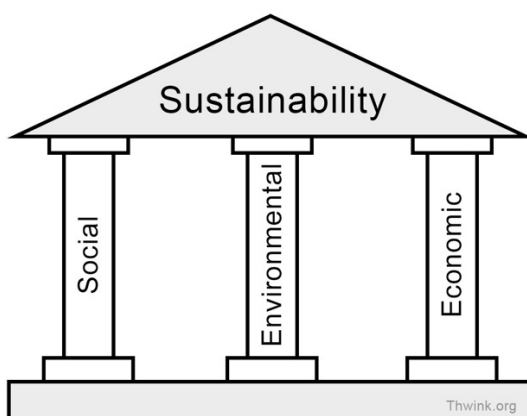


The need for a cultural pillar? Sustainability, traditional buildings and the STBA

Culture and cultural significance are recognised in sustainable community development, but overlooked in building sustainability. Retrofit schemes too often overlook the need for repair and maintenance. This talk, which builds on current discussions within the Sustainable Traditional Buildings Alliance, argues for a more holistic approach including a fourth, cultural, pillar in building sustainability, and repairs and maintenance as precursors to retrofit.
