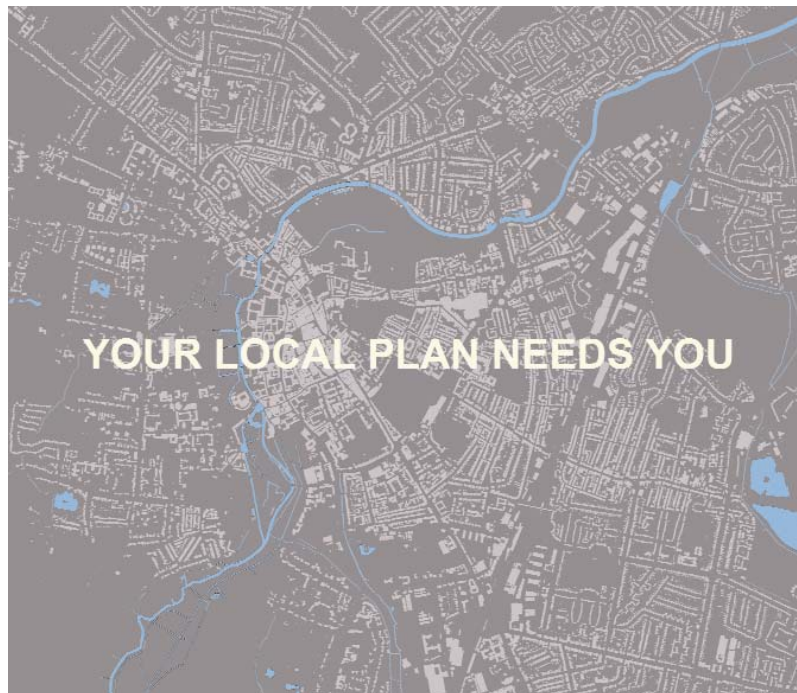


Issues and Options for a Good City Plan Accommodating Growth in Cambridge
