Mark Smith will talk about his ongoing attempts to critically join in with the work of public agencies that shape places. This field requires the designer to nimbly and sometimes opportunistically adapt their skills in order to be relevant to bodies like local authorities who are often not in need of traditional architectural projects but are in need of the kind of creative and analytical thought about places that architects can be good at. This is a strategy borne out of a desire to make projects that are of relevance to the many and avoid overly technocratic or academic approaches, and instead seek a way of being a public architect in a time when the public sector will not design or build and town planning is at the mercy of private investment.
